## The Requirement:

A building firm were to demolish an existing residential dwelling and construct a new one. The report they obtained from an arboricultural consultant required the large trees in the front garden to be protected from site excavation works, soil compaction by vehicles and the use of impermeable materials such as concrete or tarmac. Since it is a legal requirement to protect tree roots from disruptive build projects, the company turned to Ground-Guards for help.
